### **Domain name**

It's a name of website. This name is generated from IP address (Internet Protocol) on DNS servers (Domain Name Server) and support user better look for name of webpage.

## Site (same as website)

Site is name for contents of domain. Not for pages, bud complete web (e.g.: pictures, audio/video files). We can have domain without site, but not inverse.

## Page (same as webpage)

It's a separate page of website. It provides showing content (e.g.: texts, pictures) of site for end users.

### **Visitor**

Visitor is host of webpage/website. Mostly visitors are humans which would like get some information by us. But sometimes visit us a bot (it's a robot, which search internet and indexing data for search engines).

Brand names are words which are used when we would say name of company for business partners.

## **Hyperlink**

It is name for link in electronic document or web page.

It's often a webpage which is designed for searching information from other webpage.

It's software which allows us to browse (show) webpage on the Internet.
